This position is a part time, exempt role. The coach will report to the Head Football Coach. The employee will work seasonally for the sport.

Essential Functions

Primary responsibilities for this position include but are not limited to:

- Attend after school and or before practice workouts.
- Attend summer conditioning, 7 on 7 games, any football related activities
- Assist in developing season-long as well as individual game plans
- Emphasize the importance of academic excellence and assist in monitoring and maintaining high academic standards for members of the football program.
- Work cooperatively with the head coaches of other SMCA sports in order to operate a well-balanced athletic department
- Ensure consistency and relative uniformity in the implementation of and execution of offensive and defensive schemes for both varsity and sub-varsity teams
- Learn and adhere to rules specific to TAPPS Football competition
- Advocate on behalf of deserving players eligible for post-season awards/accolades and collegiate scholarships
- Attend district and state coaches meetings as required
- Supervise and mentor assistant coaches in a manner commensurate with athletic department policy and vision
